An amendment to put the "Three Species" back to their 2005 status will be offered by U.S. Representative John Carter (R) Texas District 31 on Wednesday, July 27, to the full committee of the House Appropriations Committee. This amendment would return, to the owners of one or more of the three species, the management of them in a sustainable way.

There is going to be a tremendous fight over this amendment in the committee. Our lobbyist, along with NRA's lobbyist, has been working and will continue to work to close the gap and educate the committee members on this issue before the vote is taken on Wednesday.
