

Latest Update Concerning the “Three Species”
Scimitar Horned Oryx, Addax and Dama Gazelle

In an effort to keep our membership up to date on the latest involving EWA’s appeal of Judge Kennedy’s decision involving the three species, the following is the latest information.

The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service will be joining EWA and has also given notice of appeal. Safari Club International, after earlier withdrawing their support, has also decided to join EWA in the appeal.

What does this mean to our case? By the filing of an appeal by U.S. Fish and Wildlife and Safari Club International this gives much more support to our appeal. EWA’s attorney has also informed us that he will be receiving information later this week from the court setting out the deadline for filing the briefs in this case.

The Executive Committee has also approved the hiring of Public Relations firm John Meng and Associates to help with national support for the case involving the three species as well as lobbying efforts to amend the endangered species act.

In the near future our membership will be receiving information from this office on how they can help with all of these efforts.

The future of these three species, as well as all species, is going to rely on the efforts put forth in this case.
